Flight Crew Training - Pilots Type Rating Renewal Airbus A320 Family



1. Initial Situation

A pilot with expired A320 Type Rating.

2. Course Objective

The aim of the training is to refresh and acquire necessary pilot competencies to renew the A320 Type Rating.

The type rating renewal fulfils the EASA regulatory requirements.

3. Entry Requirements

An applicant shall provide evidence of the following:

- Valid ATPL or CPL licence
- Held the A320 Type Rating
- Hold a valid Class 1 Medical certificate
- Have adequate fluency in reading, speaking and understanding of the English language to ICAO proficiency level 4, 5 or 6



The course consists of refresher training (if required) and proficiency check.

4.1. Refresher Training

The amount of refresher training, if needed, is determined on a case-by-case basis by the ATO, taking into account:

- the experience of applicant
- the amount of time elapsed since the privileges of the rating were last used
- whether the applicant has a current rating on another aircraft type or class and to what extent the operations of that aircraft are similar to the A320

The practical training on a full flight simulator (FFS) is performed on a FFS level D.

4.2. Proficiency check

After successful completion of refresher training an applicant is recommended for the proficiency check.

5. Training Documents/Textbooks/Study Materials

Student pilot will receive documentation in accordance with the training programme developed.



6. Course Completion Certificate

Successful graduates receive a certificate of completion of the refresher training, training records, CAA (Civil Aviation Authority) form from the proficiency check and other required documents in accordance with administrative procedures provided by each EASA member state.
