1. Initial Situation

A pilot holds a valid type rating that is to be revalidated.

2. Course Objective

To revalidate the A320 Type Rating.

The examination fulfils the EASA regulatory requirements.

3. Entry Requirements

An applicant shall provide evidence of the following:

- Hold valid A320 Type Rating
- Complete during the period of validity of the rating, at least:
 - i. 10 route sectors as pilot of the A320 family aircraft ("A320 family" refers to A318, A319, A320, A321); or
 - ii. 1 route sector as pilot of the A320 flown with an examiner

 These ten route sectors can be substituted by one route sector flown on the FFS under the supervision
 of an examiner
- Hold a valid Class 1 Medical certificate

4. Course Description and Duration

For the revalidation of the A320 type rating, the applicant shall pass a proficiency check in accordance with Appendix 9 Part FCL within the three months immediately preceding the expiry date of the rating.

For the purpose of this product sheet, theoretical knowledge instructors (TKI), type rating instructors (TRI) and type rating examiners (TRE) are understood as CATC instructors and examiners.

The proficiency check is performed on a full flight simulator, FFS level D.

4.1 Practical Training & Testing

> Full Flight Simulator (FFS) Session

• 1 FFS session with a type rating examiner (TRE)

The check includes 1 hour briefing and debriefing.

The whole type rating revalidation usually takes 1 day.
