1. Initial Situation

A cabin crew member requests a cabin crew instructor qualification.

2. Course Objectives

- Professional knowledge intensification, revision and completion;
- Teaching principles of how to carry out training and how to apply these principles;
- Teaching to propose and explain correct solutions of the operation situations;
- Teaching to check and assess cabin crew (CC) members' activities;
- A trained cabin crew instructor must:
 - Prove the ability to understand principles of aviation operation;
 - Identify himself/herself with them;
 - Prove the ability to identify wrong or inadequate action and imperfections in knowledge of other CC
 - Be able to make adequate decisions to eliminate incorrect procedures;
 - Be able to apply acquired knowledge into CC performance methodology.



3. Entry Requirements

- Valid CC attestation

4. Course Description and Duration

The course consists of the following parts:

- Theoretical instruction focused on:
 - Civil aviation regulations and administrative authorities in civil aviation;
 - Applicable regulations;
 - Methodology of training;
 - Evaluation
 - Barriers of Teaching Process
 - Personality of a Teacher
 - Teaching Methods
 - Didactic Principles
 - Practical Teaching Common Mistakes
 - Didactic Tests
 - 18 hours of theoretical instruction in total
- Final Skill Test
 - Approx. 1 hour

Duration of the whole course: 20 hours, i.e. 2.5 days.
