## Security Training Specialised Security Training for Air Crews D1, Initial



## 1. Initial Situation

A person is about to act as an air crew member and has no valid D1 certificate.

2. Course Objective

The aim of the Specialized Security Training for Air Crews is to raise awareness of aviation security among air crews and to fulfil the requirements of the National Security Training Programme in civil aviation, issued by the Ministry of Transport of the Czech Republic.

3. Entry Requirements

Every applicant shall document the following:

- Valid Background Check issued by the Czech CAA -
- 4. Course Description and Duration

This course is focused on specialized security awareness. The classroom instruction is done by fully qualified Security Awareness instructor and is followed by an examination. Successful candidates receive a certificate upon completion. The certificate is valid for 24 months.

Topics covered are as follows: Previous civil aviation unlawful acts, terrorist attacks and current threats analysis, Goals and organisation of civil aviation protection, incl. duties and responsibilities of Security check employees, Reporting procedures, Relevant legal requirements, Manners of appropriate reaction to security related events, Security screening point configuration and procedures, Access control and relevant procedures, Airport badges, Prohibited items and their detection, Prohibited items handling (e.g. reaction to discovery), Reconciliation methodology and requirements, Protection of Air Transporter's Check-in supplies, Work-related aircraft configuration knowledge, In-flight security precautions, Weapons transport procedures, Air marshals-related procedures, Securityrelated event reaction procedures; aircraft security protection on the ground; aircraft security search procedures.
