Security Training Specialised Training for Aircraft Security Search Personnel D2, Initial



1. Initial Situation

This course is intended for airline employees and other staff performing aircraft security search.

2. Course Objective

The aim of the Specialised Training for Aircraft Security Search Personnel is to raise awareness of aviation security among air crews and to fulfil the requirements of the National Security Training Programme in civil aviation, issued by Czech CAA.

3. Entry Requirements

Every applicant shall document the following:

Valid Security Background Check certificate issued by Czech CAA.



4. Relevant aircraft type must be available for practical training session Course Description and Duration

This course is focused on specialized security awareness. The classroom instruction is done by fully qualified Security Awareness instructor and is followed by an examination. Successful candidates receive a certificate upon completion. The certificate is valid for 24 months.

Topics covered are as follows: Aircraft security search legal requirements, Prohibited items and their detection, Prohibited items handling (e.g. reaction to discovery), Possibilities of prohibited items concealment, Work-related aircraft configuration knowledge, Performing of aircraft security search at the level appropriate for discovery of concealed prohibited items.


