IATA Dangerous Goods Regulations for Processing DG Consignments - Initial I100



1. Initial Situation

This course is recommended for personnel involved in processing dangerous goods consignments:

- Personnel working for cargo agents, consolidators and freight forwarder who are responsible for processing dangerous goods consignments from shippers to airlines
- IATA Cargo agent applicants willing to fulfil the training requirements for DGR



2. Course Objective

Upon completing this course you will be able to:

- Fulfil the regulatory compliance requirements
- Perform tasks involved in accepting dangerous goods consignments
- Apply IATA's DGR manual to process dangerous goods consignments accurately
- Discuss the legal responsibilities of stakeholders involved in the transportation of dangerous goods by air

3. Entry Requirements

Every applicant shall prove their good knowledge of written English.

4. Course Description and Duration

The IATA Dangerous Goods Course is lectured by a professional IATA Dangerous Goods instructor and the covered topics are:

Legal responsibilities of key stakeholders; Understanding and applying relevant sections of current IATA DGR; Importance of accurate identification and classification of dangerous goods; Safety implications of packaging types, and net quantity limitations; End-to-end communication of hazards and handling requirements using correct marks and labels; Radioactive material transportation; Impact of State and Operator variations on dangerous goods acceptance.

Courses are carried out in Czech language (in English on request), a written exam is in English.

4.1 Theoretical Training

➤ Classroom instruction

- 40 hours of classroom instruction with a professional IATA instructor.

The whole Dangerous Goods Regulations Course usually takes 5 days.
