The Dangerous Goods Course is lectured by a professional Dangerous Goods instructor and the covered topics are:

Legal responsibilities of key stakeholders; Understanding and applying relevant sections of current IATA DGR; Importance of accurate identification and classification of dangerous goods; Safety implications of packaging types, and net quantity limitations; End-to-end communication of hazards and handling requirements using correct marks and labels; Radioactive material transportation; Impact of State and Operator variations on dangerous goods acceptance.

The courses as well as a written test are carried out in Czech language (English on request).
